1. Deadline for scholarship applications is July 1st, 2014, 11:59 PM EST. (No exceptions).
2. Refer to criteria below for eligibility requirements. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

The attainment of knowledge is a never-ending process, which requires dedication, motivation, and support both emotional and financial.

The Locksley Anthony Henry Scholarship Foundation will serve as an avenue of financial support for students looking to further their education, through a post secondary institution. Students elected for the scholarship will be presented with a check for a portion of the tuition to the school of their choice.

Award Components: Each year, the Locksley Anthony Scholarship Foundation will select three (3) new graduating NYC public high school senior, each of whom will receive a \$1,500 annual scholarship (\$750 per semester- fall/spring) to be used for tuition purposes at the school of their choice.

Award Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident with a permanent resident ID card or current passport.
2. Applicant must have a minimum, cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale or 70 or higher on a 100 point scale.
3. Applicant must be a graduating senior at a NYC public high school who will attend college.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Completed application form.
2. Two letters of recommendations (previous/current teacher, faculty member, advisor etc.)
3. A copy of their most recent transcript with cumulative grade point average
4. Personal Essay: If education was a key, what door would it open for you? 500 words or less.

Deadline for the application is July 1st, 2014. Applications postmarked or submitted after this date will not be considered. No emailed or incomplete applications will be considered.
